Dear,

As you are aware that Government of India has expanded contraceptive choices through introduction of Injectable Contraceptives (under Antara Program) and Centchroman (Chhayya).

The states needs to ensure that all the dimensions of programs are covered for smooth implementation and roll out of new contraceptives. GoI has already successfully completed the following for your state:

- Training of Master Trainers for new contraceptives (MTOT) for service provision.
- Orientation of Program Managers and ASHA nodal officers for involving ASHAs for new contraceptives- in Delhi on 5-6th Dec 2016
- Orientation of Logistic Managers for streamlining supply chain management- in Delhi on 5-6th Dec 2016

Centchroman has already been supplied to the states whereas the supply of Injectable contraceptives will reach shortly.

State needs to take up the following activities urgently and the compliance/report needs to be send to GoI.

1. Map facilities for roll out of injectable contraceptives. The facility mapping has been included with the DAP (District Action Plan) exercise.
2. ***State to submit the detailed training and orientation plan for all the trainings and orientation mentioned above for 2016-17 and 2017-18.*** The training and orientation plan may be submitted to GoI by 30th January 2017 to sikdarsk.dcfp@gmail.com and neidhi03@gmail.com
3. ***States to strictly ensure that the trainings for new contraceptives should be as per GoI guidelines and states to use the standardized GoI manuals and training techniques as conducted in the MTOT for the same.***

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4. Ensure availability of required infrastructure, logistics and Infection prevention supplies
5. Translation of the Register format and MPA card in local language, if required
6. Ensuring the availability of registers (injectable and oral pills), MPA card at the facilities according to the phase of implementation
7. Streamlining the supply chain for contraceptives.

The strategic action points and guidance note for State is placed at Annexure 1. The list of participants attended and completed the MTOT is placed at Annexure 2.

Annexure 1

New Contraceptive Roll out

Strategic Action 1: Quality Service Delivery

Service Delivery Site:

Injectable Contraceptives:

- The roll out will be in three phases-
 - Phase 1: Roll out in district level facilities (District Hospitals and Medical Colleges)
 - Phase 2: Roll out in sub-district/block level facilities (SDH, CHC/Block PHC)
 - Phase 3: Roll out in PHC and SC
 - **For Mission Parivar Districts (Assam, UP, Bihar, Rajasthan, MP, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh)** the roll out will be till the Subcenter level at one go.

Centchroman:

- The roll out will be similar to that of other contraceptive pills (COC and E-pill).
- Roll out will be across all the levels of facility (till SC).
- Centchroman (Chhayya) may also be provided under ASHA kit for community distribution.

Eligibility of Providers:

Injectable Contraceptives:

- **Doctors (MBBS and above, AYUSH), SN/LHV/ANM**
- **First shot** of injection be administered **under the guidance of a trained MBBS doctor** after proper screening. Subsequent shots may be administered by trained AYUSH doctor, SN/LHV/ANM.

Centchroman:

- **Doctors (MBBS and above, AYUSH), SN/LHV/ANM**
- For **distribution through ASHA** it is mandatory that the first dose to be prescribed by doctors (MBBS and above, AYUSH), SN/ LHV/ANM after proper screening of the client.

Key action points for State/District:

Facility Readiness:

- **Injectable Contraceptives:** Mapping the facilities for Phase I/II/III for injectable MPA. (For MPV districts facilities till SC will be covered in one go). Collation of district wise list of mapped facilities and submission to GoI. (The mapping has also been done in DAPs)

- Ensuring adequate infrastructure requirement
- Rational deployment of trained provider.
- Printing and distribution of Record format, register format, MPA card (available in GoI website). Job aids for ASHA, IEC material and other relevant material for health facilities (ASHA job aids will be shortly shared by GoI).
- Distribution of job aids for new contraceptives to ASHA for further distribution to clients
- Ensuring wall writings at the public health facilities to increase awareness on new contraceptives.

Infection Prevention Practices:

- Directions to districts for ensuring availability of IP supplies and bio medical waste management
- Ensuring availability of IP Supplies
- Monitoring and follow up for adherence of IP practices

Monitoring and Reporting:

- Ensuring availability of record keeping and reporting materials (As mentioned in Reference manual for Injectable; Facility register-Annexure 11; Reference Manual for Oral Pills; ASHA format and Facility Register-Annexure 11 and 11A)
- Translation of the Register format and MPA card in local language
- Ensuring the availability of registers (injectable and oral pills), MPA card at the facilities according to the phase of implementation
- Ensuring availability of written instructions/ routine protocols for providing injectable MPA (Antara Program) services
- In Phase I: Monthly desk review at state level
- After Phase I: Quarterly review at State level; Monthly desk review at district level; Fortnight review at DH and Medical College level.

Strategic Action 2: Capacity Building

The training for New Contraceptives will follow a cascade model. The training/orientation will be provided to the following cadre of the staff:

1. Service Providers
2. Program Management Staff
3. RMNCH+A Counsellors
4. Store Keepers
5. Frontline workers- ANM/ASHA

Service Provider Trainings:

Level and roll out of training:

- Regional MTOT was conducted at the National Level-(Northern States- 5-6 Dec; Eastern States- 15-16 Dec; Western States- 19-20 Dec; Southern States- 5-6 Jan; NE States- 16-17 Jan).
- Master Trainers nominated from states were trained in each of these regional MTOTs.
- The master trainers' trained during Regional TOTs may be utilized to develop trainers at Divisional level in the state. These divisional level trainers will further train the service providers in the field.
- For smaller states/UTs master trainers may directly be utilized to train district level trainers or service providers.
- State to ensure greater nomination of the nursing personnel (GNM/ANM/PHN/LHV etc) in the trainings.

A. State (TOT) Training of Trainers':

Following the Regional TOT the state will conduct TOTs so as to ensure at least one trainer in each division.

- **Number-** 1 to 2 (Will vary from state to state as per the number of districts)
- **Location-** Medical College/District Hospital/State Training Center (any other place with adequate training infrastructure as per GoI Reference Manual for Injectable Contraceptives, 2016)
- **Eligibility of Trainers-** Master Trainers' trained in Regional TOT
- **Eligibility of Trainee-** MBBS and above, AYUSH, Staff Nurse (GNM/ANM/PHN/LHV etc)
- **Duration:** 2 days
- **Batch Size-** 25-30
- **Material:** Developed and approved by GoI
- **Responsibility:** State FP and State Training teams
- **Funds:** NHM PIP
- **Agenda:** Same as of Regional TOT

B. Training of Service Providers:

Following the State level TOT the state should ensure training of service providers as per the Phase of Implementation, so as to saturate the facilities accordingly.

- **Number-** Will vary as per the number of participants in the district
- **Location-** Medical College/District Hospital/District Training Center (any other place with adequate training infrastructure as per GoI Reference Manual for Injectable Contraceptives, 2016 and Reference manual for Oral Contraceptive Pills, 2016)
- **Eligibility of Trainers-** Trainers' trained in State TOT/ Master Trainers trained in Regional TOT
- **Eligibility of Trainee-** MBBS and above, AYUSH, Staff Nurse, LHV, ANM
 - **Phase I-** Participants to be nominated from Medical Colleges and District Hospitals
 - **Phase II-** Participants to be nominated from SDH and CHC
 - **Phase III-** Participants to be nominated from PHC and SC

(For MPV districts the trainings will be till SC level)

- **Duration:** 2 Day (1st Day-Injectable; 2nd Day- Oral Pill)
(States are free to club training on Oral Pills with Injectable training according to type of participants or may conduct it separately)
- **Batch Size-** 25-30
- **Material:** Developed and approved by GoI (Reference Manual for Injectable Contraceptives, 2016; Reference Manual for Oral Contraceptive Pills, 2016)
- **Responsibility:** District FP and District Training teams
- **Funds:** NHM PIP
- **Agenda:** As Given in Reference Manual for Injectable Contraceptives, 2016; Reference Manual for Oral Contraceptive Pills, 2016
- **Post Training Follow up:** Follow up should be conducted within 2-3 months by District Training Coordinator/CMO/DQAC/DISC utilizing the Post training follow up checklist as provided in both the above mentioned manuals.
Action plan should be prepared based on findings of follow up for further necessary actions/retraining or/new trainings

Program Management Staff:

The division/district wise orientation to be clubbed with divisional/district review workshops/meeting

RMNCH+A Counsellors:

State/Divisional level Orientation of RMNCH+A Counsellors

- **Number-** Will vary according to the number of Counsellors in the State
- **Location-** State Training Center/Divisional Training Center (any other place with adequate training infrastructure)
- **Eligibility of Facilitators-** State Master Trainers', State Trainers' for New Contraceptives
- **Eligibility of Participants-** RMNCH+A Counsellors
- **Duration:** 1 Day
- **Batch Size-** 30-40
- **Material:** Counsellor Orientation material prepared by GoI and will be uploaded on website soon.
- **Responsibility:** State FP Team, State Training Team
- **Funds:** NHM PIP

Logistic personnel/Store Keepers:

Level and roll out of training:

- National orientation for Program Managers, State logistic personnel was conducted on 5-6 Dec.
- State to further orient district logistic personnel, block logistic personnel, Facility Store keepers and ANMs on family planning logistic management with a special focus on new contraceptives as per the material and tools shared by GoI.
- NHM funds may be utilized for the same.

Front line workers- ANM/ASHA:

Level and roll out of training:

- National orientation for Program Managers, State ASHA nodal officers was conducted on 5-6 Dec.
- State to further orient district ASHA nodal officers, Block nodal officers, ASHA Facilitators, ANMs and ASHAs on new contraceptives as per the material and tools shared by GoI.
- NHM funds may be utilized for the same.

Strategic Action 3: Commodity Security

- Written indents should be issued by the store as per GoI logistic guidelines.
- State/District to refer GoI logistic guidelines (D.O.NO.N.11027/1/2015-FP), Reference manual for Injectable Contraceptives, Reference manual for Oral Pills

Important considerations for injectable contraceptives:

- Storage in upright position, in a cool dry, well-ventilated warehouse/storeroom at room temperature between 15-30°C.
- Away from direct sunlight or extreme heat and should not be kept in the refrigerator/freezer.
- In places with lower temperature (<10 degree) the vials may be stored in wooden almirah or in wooden boxes.
- In a warehouse/store should be well equipped with exhaust fans. Additional fans can be used during summer to keep the room at the desired temperature.
