Agenda wise following resolutions are taken:-

Agenda No.1:-

Confirmation of the proceedings of the previous meeting dated 08.08.2023.

The proceedings of the previous meeting dated 08.08.2023 are confirmed.

Agenda No.03:-

To monitor the progress of respective agenda resolution taken in the previous meeting dated 08.08.2023:-

(i) Deferred Agenda No.3 (c) part-II relating to framing of rules.

(ii) 3 (d) relating to accommodation, etc. of the Committee in the light of the report submitted by CA-Member and accepted by the Committee.

Both these agendas were taken together and Mr. Sanjay Kumar Singh assured to take personal interest in the matter and get everything expedited.

Agenda No.04

To consider the report of the Working Group with respect to the proposals for Post Graduate courses submitted by Lord Buddha Koshi Medical College, Saharsa and after hearing the authorized representatives of the aforesaid colleges pass necessary orders on fixation of the fee for the session 2023-24.

After over all consideration of the materials available, the comments of the Working Group relating to income and expenditure, etc., and hearing the college authorities, the fee for Post Graduate Degree courses per annum considering the inflation at the rate of 7.44 % is fixed by the committee (1) MS Obstetrics & Gynecology course at Rs.33 Lac (2) MD General Medicine course at Rs.25.50 Lac (3) MD Anesthesiology course at Rs.11 Lac (4) MD Pediatrics course at Rs.25.50 Lac (5) MS General Surgery course at Rs.17.50 Lac (6) MS-Orthopedics course at Rs.21.50 Lac including the development fee for the batch 2023-25 excluding hostel, mess charges and transportation to non-residents in hostel. However, it is made clear that the college cannot realize the amounts more than what they have already mentioned in their proposal .

The Committee directs that the institution shall not charge as directly or indirectly any other amount over and above the amount fixed as fee and if any other amount is charged under any other head or guise that is donation, fee by any other name the same would amount to charging of capitation fee. Any deviation of this order of the Committee will invite serious consequences.

It is further made clear that since the college has been granted permission for intake of the students for the academic year 2023-24 only, the above fee has been fixed only for the said batch for the period 02 years.

It is expected that the college authorities will be particular in future and submit their proposal for fixation of the fee of the students for the next academic year well within time even in anticipation of the renewal or allotting letter of permission as the case may be from NMC or simultaneous with the initiation of process by them for renewal, etc.

Since before the order was ready for signature, Mr. Sanjay Kumar Singh, had to leave the meeting for other engagement, hence, let extract of the order be communicated to the college at once, reasoned order will follow soon after being ready for communication.

To consider the reports of the Working Group with respect to the proposals submitted by the colleges, namely, (i) Lord Buddha Koshi Medical College & Hospital, Saharsa (ii) Shree Narayan Medical Institute & Hospital Mahabir Nagar, Bherdhari, Saharsa, (iii) Madhubani Medical College, Madhubani (iv) Netaji Subhas Medical College & Hospital, Bihta, Patna and (v) R.D.J.M. Medical College & Hospital Turki, Muzaffarpur and after hearing the authorized representatives of the aforesaid colleges pass necessary orders on fixation of the fee for the session 2023-24.

On over all consideration of the materials available, the comments of the Working Group relating to income and expenditure, etc., and hearing the representatives of the colleges, the fee for Under Graduate degree course per annum for the batch 2023-28 considering inflation @ 7.44% is respectively fixed for the colleges, namely, (i) Lord Buddha Koshi Medical College & Hospital, Saharsa at Rs. 10.50 Lac (ii) Shree Narayan Medical Institute & Hospital Mahabir Nagar, Bherdhari, Sharsa at Rs.9.80 Lac, (iii) Madhubani Medical College,

Madhubani at Rs.14.00 Lac and (iv) Netaji Subhas Medical College & Hospital, Bihta, Patna at Rs. 16.25 Lac, and for NRI USD \$ 35000/- including the development fee, but excluding hostel, mess charges and transportation to non-residents in hostel. However, it is made clear that the colleges cannot realize amount more than what they have already mentioned in the respective proposals.

The Committee directs that the institution shall not charge as directly or indirectly any other amount over and above the amount fixed as fee and if any other amount is charged under any other head or guise that is donations, fee by any other name the same would amount to charging of capitation fee. Any deviation of this order of the committee will invite serious consequences.

It is further made clear that since the college has been granted permission for intake of the students for the academic year 2023-24 only, the above fee has been fixed only for the said batch for the period of 4.5 years.

It is expected that the college authorities will be particular in future and submit their proposal for fixation of the fee of the students for the next academic year well within time even in anticipation of the renewal or allotting letter of permission as the case may be from NMC or simultaneous with the initiation of process by them for renewal, etc.

Since before the order with respect to Lord Buddha Koshi Medical College and Hospital Saharsa was ready for signature, Mr. Sanjay Kumar Singh, had to leave the meeting for other engagement, hence, let extract of the order be communicated to the college at once. The reasoned order will follow soon after being ready for communication.




