



Agenda No.04:-

04. To consider and discuss the report of the Working Group with respect to the proposal submitted on 17.12.2024 vide ref. no. HMCH/155/24 dated 16.12.2024 by Himalaya Medical College & Hospital, Chiksi, Paliganj, Patna and pass necessary orders.

After hearing the authorities of the college and on due consideration, the Committee passed 47 pages reasoned order which be kept with the file after communicating to all concerned under the signature of Dr. Ranjeet Kumar Sinha, O.S.D., the operative portion of which is as follows:-

After overall consideration of the materials available, comments of the working group relating to income and expenditure, etc., the committee since finding the revised proposal nearer to the opinion already arrived at hence, under compelling circumstances, the fee for under Graduate degree course per annum is fixed by the Committee at Rs. 15,50,000/- including development fee for the



session 2024-29 excluding hostel and mess charges. However, it is made clear that the college authorities cannot realize the amount more than what they have already mentioned in their revised proposal submitted before the Committee under above heads.

Since the college has already taken admission and realized fee from the students as mentioned in paragraph Nos.04 and 05 of the order which is in excess of the amount fixed above. Accordingly, the difference amount, making the Committee simultaneously aware of, is to be refunded to the students by the college directly in their bank accounts strictly within 30 days from today, failing which they have to pay 9% interest upon the amount, if paid, within next 30 days, i.e., within 60 days from today. In the event of failure, the College will be liable to pay compound interest @ 18% till the date of actual payment.

The Committee directs that the institution shall not charge as directly or indirectly any other amount over and above the amount fixed as fee and if any other amount is charged under any other head or guise that is donations, fee by any other name the same would amount to charging of capitation fee. Any deviation of this order of the committee will invite serious consequences.

It is further made clear that since the college has been granted permission for intake of the students for the session 2024-29, the above fee has been fixed only for the said batch for the period of 4.5 years. The college is expected to come with its proposal and relevant supporting papers in the event of permission being granted by the NMC for the next academic session. Well within time as per direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.


It is discussed and the Committee finds a reasonable enhancement from Rs.4,000/- to Rs.5,000/- per day.


