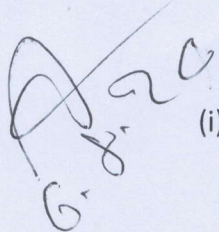

JMD/Pat/2025-2026/Q-112 dated 27.07.2026 and vide Gazette notification S.O. 43 dated 27th February 2019 and subsequent 'Shram Sansadhan avam Pravashi Shramik Kalayan Vibhag' Bihar Government notification annexure II dated 01.04.2026 and annexure A provided by JMD Services dated 05.08.2026, are being reproduced hereunder and the proposal for enhancement of wages with effect from 1.4.2026 stands approved.

Sub:- Regarding revision of wages of outsourced staff.

Dear Sir,

With reference to the discussion held in your esteemed office, we respectfully submit the following for your kind consideration:

1. Mr. Anil Kumar Srivastava, working as an Assistant, is presently receiving a gross monthly wage of Rs. 16,000, which is lower than the **Highly Skilled** minimum wage prescribed by the Labour Resources Department, Government of Bihar. As per the revised Minimum Wages effective from **01.04.2026**, the wage for a Highly Skilled worker is Rs. 672 per day, amounting to Rs. 17,472 per month (Rs. 672 x 26 days), Excluding applicable statutory benefits such as EPF and ESIC, Service Charges, GST. Therefore, his wages may kindly be revised accordingly.
2. Mr. Vinod Kumar Pandit, working as a Data Entry Operator, has completed more than five years of continuous service under the skilled category. As per Notification No. 5/M.W.-402/2009 L&R-994 issued by the Labour Resources Department, Government of Bihar, effective from **01.04.2019**, a worker with more than five years of experience is eligible for up gradation to the next immediate category. Accordingly, he may be upgraded from Skilled to Highly Skilled and paid wages applicable to the upgraded category. As per the revised Minimum Wages effective from **01.04.2026**, the wage for a Highly Skilled worker is Rs. 672 per day, amounting to Rs. 17,472 per month (Rs. 672 x 26 days), Excluding applicable statutory benefits such as EPF and ESIC, Service Charges, GST. Therefore, his wages may kindly be revised accordingly.
3. Mr. Pinku Kumar, working as an Office Boy, has completed more than five years of continuous service under the Semi-Skilled category. In accordance with Notification No. 5/M.W.-402/2009 L&R-994 issued by the Labour Resources Department, Government of Bihar, effective from **01.04.2019**, he is eligible for up gradation to the next immediate category. Accordingly, he may be upgraded from Semi-Skilled to Skilled and paid wages applicable to the upgraded category. As per the revised Minimum Wages effective from **01.04.2026**, the wage for a Skilled worker is Rs. 551 per day, amounting to Rs. 14,326 per month (Rs. 551 x 26 days), Excluding applicable statutory benefits such as EPF and ESIC, Service Charges, GST. Therefore, his wages may kindly be revised accordingly.

In view of the above facts and the applicable provisions of the Government of Bihar, we request your kind approval for the revision and up gradation of wages of the above-mentioned outsourced staff.

04. To consider and discuss the report of the Working Group prepared in the light of letter submitted by Mithila Minority Dental College & Hospital, Darbhanga. vide Ref. No. MMDCH-1028/26 dated 21.03.2026 received by speed post on 26.05.2026 and subsequent proposal & other documents placed on 18.06.2026 before the Working Group for scrutiny & verification with respect to fee fixation for BDS and PG courses for the batch 2026-27, and pass necessary orders after hearing the college authorities.

On due consideration the Committee passed 47 pages reasoned order which be kept with the file after communicating to all concerned under the signature of Dr. Ranjeet Kumar Sinha, OSD., the operative portion of which is as follows:-

In view of the delaying tendency and conduct of the college apparently causing undue hindrance the committee find its proper to turn down the prayer for further adjournment and as resolved in previous meeting, giving respect to the direction of the Apex court in para 23 of P.A. Inamdar case referred in para 01 at page 01 of this order, pass necessary orders on the material already provide by the college.

After overall consideration of the materials available, comments of the Working Group relating to income, expenditure. and overall submissions made by the authorities of the college, the finding of the Committee already arrived at hence under compelling circumstances, the fee for Under Graduate degree course per annum considering the inflation @ 4.38% is fixed by the Committee including development fee excluding hostel and mess charges at Rs. 2.88 Lacs for the batch 2026-30 and for P.G. courses degree and diploma respectively for the batch 2026-29 and 2026-28 as detailed below:-

On due consideration the Committee passed 29 pages reasoned order which be kept with the file after communicating to all concerned under the signature of Dr. Ranjeet Kumar Sinha, OSD., the operative portion of which is as follows:-

After overall consideration of the materials available, comments of the working group relating to income and expenditure, etc., and overall submissions made by the authority of the college, the fee for Under Graduate Degree course per annum considering inflation at the rate of 4.38% is fixed by the Committee at Rs.14.25 Lacs for resident candidates and USD 28,000 for NRI's including development fee and Rs. 2.75 lacs for hostel and mess charges for both categories for the batch 2026-31.

However, it is made clear that the college cannot realize the amount in the above heads more than what they have already mentioned in their original proposal vide Annexure-F reproduced in para 03 of this order submitted before the Committee.

The Committee directs that the institution shall not charge either directly or indirectly

any other amount over and above the amount fixed as fee and if any other amount is charged under any other head or guise that is donations, fee by any other name the same would amount to charging of capitation fee. Any deviation of this order of the committee will invite serious consequences.

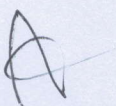

On due consideration the Committee passed 28 pages reasoned order which be kept with the file after communicating to all concerned under the signature of Dr. Ranjeet Kumar Sinha, OSD., the operative portion of which is as follows:-

After overall consideration of the materials available, comments of the working group relating to income and expenditure, etc., and overall submissions made by the authorities of the college, the fee for Under Graduate Degree course per annum considering inflation at the rate of 4.38% is fixed by the Committee at Rs.12.75 Lacs for resident candidates and USD 35,000 for NRI's including development fee and Rs. 2.75 lacs for hostel and mess charges for both categories for the batch 2026-31.

However, it is made clear that the college cannot realize the amount in the above heads more than what they have already mentioned in their original proposal vide Annexure-F reproduced in para 03 of this order submitted before the Committee.
